

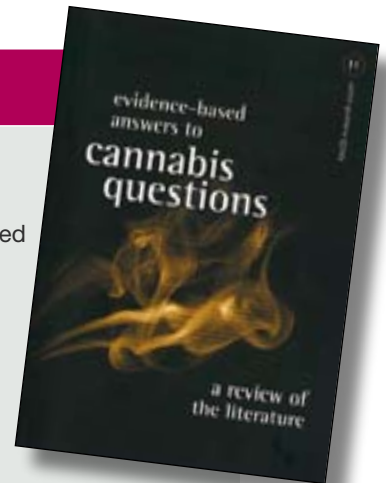


Australian National Council on Drugs (ANCD)

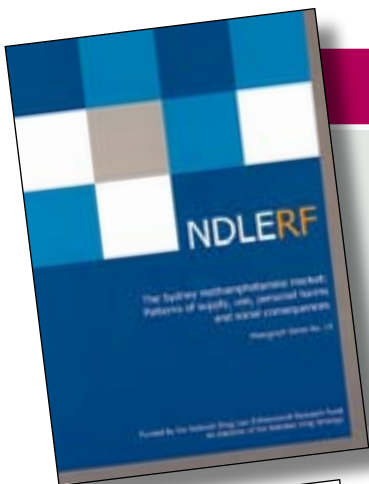


Register of Australian Drug and Alcohol Research (RADAR)

National Drug Research Institute (NDRI)

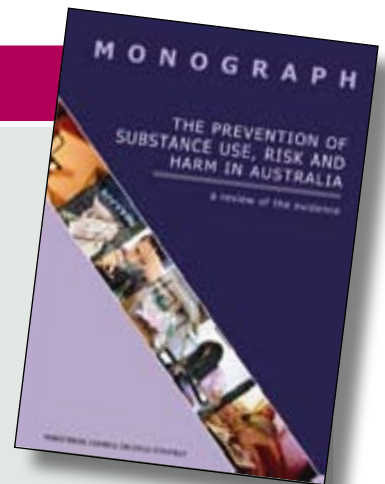
